It is available at Lowes Home Centers in a Valspar Ultra semi-gloss paint & primer+. We still have our plenty left in our gallon, if you'd like to come by. It doesn't take much so why buy when you can borrow? BTW, don't get worried if it looks kind of blue-grey when you first brush it on; it dries to the right shade.
